1. Enclosed you will find the Registration Package for the upcoming AFSA Division 6 Professional Development Summit (PDS or "Summit") to be held 26-28 March 2023, at the Orleans Hotel and Casino, Las Vegas, NV. This year's Theme for the PDS is

"Service, Leadership and Advocacy"

The Summit is both a reflection of our outstanding professional organization and recognition that we need to do everything we can to ensure that AFSA is always there for us in the future, working hard to protect benefits and quality-of-life initiatives for the total force and their families. As changed in August 2018 at the worldwide Professional Airmen's Conference and AFSA International Conference, AFSA is made up of membership by all services, all grades, active duty, Guard, Reserves, retirees, veterans and their family members and survivors.
3. The Opening Breakfast Guest Speaker this year will be CMSgt Hope L. Skibitsky, Command Chief, Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center, Joint Base, San Antonio, Texas. The Guest Speaker for the Honors Banquet will be the 11th Chief Master Sergeant of the Air Force, Chief David J. Campanale. Each of these leaders strongly supports our efforts in AFSA and each will no doubt deliver an inspiring message.
4. This Summit will be our ninth gathering of members of Division 6 and the sixth at the Orleans Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas. Last year's conference had the highest attendance and we hope for an even larger event in 2023. The Orleans Hotel and Casino offers a superb conference center for our official business as well as a multitude of other activities during your personal time. The low costs, and the location, will give you additional opportunities to visit the fabulous Las Vegas Strip.
5. Please review the enclosed registration package. The package includes:
 - a. Summit Registration Form (one form per person, please make additional copies as needed).
 - b. Summit Fact Sheet with details of hotel pricing, registration and dress code.
 - c. Summit Objectives and Information.
 - d. Advertisement contract for organizations/sponsors for space in the Summit magazine. Please consider a Chapter advertisement of at least ½ page to support the Division 6 Summit and to highlight your chapter. Advertisements allow us to keep the Summit costs as low as possible.

6. The agenda for our 3-day Summit is packed with official and unofficial business and allows adequate time to enjoy all that Las Vegas has to offer. The negotiated hotel rate is \$35.00 per room (\$58.00 for Friday and Saturday night, 3/24/23 & 3/25/23) plus applicable tax rates. These are very good rates for rooms. Check out the hotel website at www.oleanscasino.com for additional information. Reservations for reduced rates MUST be made by 22 February 2023. We cannot emphasize enough how important it is to make a hotel reservation early. Last year, rooms filled up fast and the discounted rooms were difficult to attain closer to the conference. If you make a reservation, secure it with first night payment, it can be cancelled up to 48 hours prior to the first day of arrival should your plans change.
7. Please discuss the Summit within your Chapter and encourage support and attendance by as many members as possible. Early registration is \$145.00, which includes all activities and ends on 2 March 2023. The Summit Manager for this year is your Division 6 President, MSgt James Zwiebel and he has assembled a great team to make sure your attendance will be professionally beneficial, educational and enjoyable.
